

3 performers (I, I, II)

instructions)

1. This piece should be performed at least three times but no more than five times consecutively. One performance = one movement. There should be short pauses between movements. Alternative version: Three to five performances; each performance at a different point in a concert.

2. There are two 15-second segments. 1st 2nd

3. The conductor (optional) indicates the beginnings of segments and the end of the piece.

4. Performers (lined in a row) are to stand at a military "attention" position, look straight ahead, and maintain a serious expression.

5. Each performer chooses line a,b, or C.

6. Bracketed events are done anywhere within specified segments, unless otherwise indicated.

- 7. During fragments, arms + hands go straight up and stay up until the piece ends: line $a = \frac{\text{left}}{\text{right}}$ arm + hand (open) up line $b = \frac{\text{line}}{\text{both}}$ arms + hands (open) up
- 8. T = hummed note within range of highest possible notes; very expressive.
- 9. 1 = 60 72
